Foundation Announces Year-End Human Services Grants

Cincinnati, OH—The Carol Ann and Ralph V. Haile, Jr./U.S. Bank Foundation announces that \$105,000 has been awarded to five organizations in its second cycle of Human Services grants for 2009. The Foundation understands that basic human needs, such as food and shelter, go unmet for many residents in the region. While the Foundation's core focus areas (Arts, Education and Community Development) address long-term solutions, it recognizes that short-term help is an immediate need in the community. Like the Hailes, the Foundation believes that is part of its collective responsibility.

Human Services is the only area in which the Foundation solicits grant requests through a competitive application process. Twenty agencies completed a letter of intent, expressing an interest in seeking funds, of which five were invited to complete an application.

Organizations that will benefit from the Haile/U.S. Bank Foundation are:

Cincinnati/Hamilton County Continuum of Care for the Homeless, Inc. (CoC)

\$25,000 grant to support a centralized access hotline helping families to find shelters.

Hyde Park Multi-Service Center for Older Adults

\$15,000 grant to support case management services for the elderly.

Senior Services of Northern Kentucky

\$25,000 matching grant to provide transportation for the elderly.

Society of St. Vincent de Paul

\$20,000 grant to support their Emergency Assistance Program.

Transitions, Inc.

\$15,000 grant to provide affordable rental housing and social services to formerly homeless individuals.
